**SHOW RULES GENERAL** 1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of SGBA Summer Extravaganza. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully. 2. This show is sanctioned by the Canadian Meat Goat Association; therefore, CMGA rules will govern. 3. Purebred and Percentage entries must be registered with the CMGA and CLRC. 4. CMGA sanctions the following classes: Purebred Does, Percentage Does, Commercial Does, Purebred Bucks, and Market Kids. 5. All registered animals, regardless of age, must have original registration papers at the show. No papers, no show. 6. Commercial animals must have a recorded ear tag or tattoo. 7. Exhibitors are responsible for their own feed and bedding. Hay and Straw will be sold on site and able to order with entries. 8. Barns open for arrival of goats at 1 PM, Thursday July 27/2017, and all animals must be in the barns no later than 10:00PM Thursday July 27. Release begins at 8:00am. Sunday, July 30, and all exhibitors MUST be out by 8:00 PM on Sunday . Anyone needing to stay longer must be approved by the SGBA Summer Extravaganza.

**ENTRIES** 1. Entry fee is \$25.00/entry. Entries close June 15/2017 at 8PM. 2. All animals entered/shown in Special Group Classes must be entered in the individual classes of their respected division. 3. Substitutions will be allowed until July 15 at 8PM. Only one substitution per exhibitor per class will be allowed. 4. Exhibitors wishing to substitute must email [sgbasummerextravaganza@gmail.com](mailto:sgbasummerextravaganza@gmail.com) with the information pertaining to substitution. 5. Late Entries will be allowed until June 30 at 8PM, late entries must be emailed to [sgbasummerextravaganza@gmail.com](mailto:sgbasummerextravaganza@gmail.com) and funds must be received no later then July 15th , a late fee of 10\$ will apply to the entry fee for all late entries.

**STALLING** 1. **NO MORE THEN 3 MATURE ANIMALS PER STALL OR 5 KIDS/JUNIORS/SMALL BREEDS.** 2. Stalling fee of \$51 per stall for the weekend will be charged.

**TATTOOS** 1. Purebred and Percentage animals must have legible tattoos. 2. Animals with unhealed tattoos may be disqualified and may not be allowed to show (show committee's discretion). 3. Illegible tattoos or tattoos not corresponding exactly to the information on the registration papers will result in disqualification and the animal will not be allowed to show.

**HEALTH CHECK** 1. All animals will be inspected by a veterinarian and/or committee of three CMGA members in good standing for signs of parasites, disease, and infectious or contagious conditions. It is at the discretion of the committee to disqualify any animal with health faults. 2. Animals not passing inspection must, if deemed necessary by the veterinarian and/or committee, be removed from the premises. 3. Owners/exhibitors must be present during the vet check.

**GRIEVANCE PROCESS** 1. Any complaints must be made in writing and sent by 8:00 AM the day after the protest to the CMGA, the SGBA, and the Show Committee. A copy with a \$100.00 deposit may be sent to SGBA Summer Extravaganza, where they will investigate. 2. Interrupting a show to complain is not acceptable. 3. Corrections can be made, if needed, after the show.

## **SECTION 1A – PUREBRED DOE CLASSES**

### **Junior Section**

1. Junior Doe Kid, up to 5 months as of show date.
2. Intermediate Doe Kid, 5-8 months as of show date.
3. Senior Doe Kid, 8 months but less than 12 as of show date.
4. Yearling Doe, dry (not having kidded), older than 12 months but less than 24.
5. Junior Champion Purebred Doe: Chosen from first place does in Classes 1 – 4. Reserve Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

### **Senior Section - All does must have kidded in last 12 months prior to show date.**

6. Yearling Doe, having kidded, born 2016
7. Two Year old Doe born January 1 2015-December 31 2015
8. 3-4 Year Old Doe born January 1 2013- December 31-2014
9. 5 Year old and Up Doe born 2012 and older
10. Senior Champion Purebred Doe: Chosen from all first place does in Classes 6 – 9. Reserve Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place does, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
11. Grand Champion Purebred Doe: Chosen from Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Doe shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood next to the Grand Champion in its individual age class.

## **SECTION 1B – PERCENTAGE DOE CLASSES**

### **Junior Section**

12. Junior Doe Kid, up to 5 months as of show date.
13. Intermediate Doe Kid, 5-8 months as of show date.
14. Senior Doe Kid, 8 months but less than 12 as of show date.
15. Yearling Doe, dry (not having kidded), older than 12 months but less than 24.
16. Junior Champion Percentage Doe: Chosen from first place does in Classes 12 – 15. Reserve

Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

**Senior Section - All does must have kidded in last 12 months prior to show date.**

17. Yearling Doe, having kidded, born 2016
18. Two Year old Doe born January 1 2015-December 31 2015
19. 3-4 Year Old Doe born January 1 2013- December 31-2014
20. 5 Year old and Up Doe born 2012 and older
21. Senior Champion Percentage Doe: Chosen from all first place does in Classes 17 – 20. Reserve Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place does, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
22. Grand Champion Percentage Doe: Chosen from Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Percentage Doe shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood next to the Grand Champion in its individual age class.
23. Senior Champion: Chosen from the first place does in Classes 16 – 18. Reserve Senior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
24. Grand Champion Percentage Doe: Chosen from the Junior and Senior Champions. Reserve Grand Champion Percentage Doe shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood second to the Grand Champion in its individual age class.

**SECTION 1C – COMMERCIAL DOE CLASSES**

**Junior Section**

25. Junior Doe Kid, up to 5 months as of show date.
26. Intermediate Doe Kid, 5-8 months as of show date.
27. Senior Doe Kid, 8 months but less than 12 as of show date.
28. Yearling Doe, dry (not having kidded), older than 12 months but less than 24.
29. Junior Champion Commercial Doe: Chosen from first place does in Classes 25 – 28. Reserve Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

**Senior Section - All does must have kidded in last 12 months prior to show date.**

30. Yearling Doe, having kidded, born 2016
31. Two Year old Doe born January 1 2015-December 31 2015
32. 3-4 Year Old Doe born January 1 2013- December 31-2014
33. 5 Year old and Up Doe born 2012 and older
34. Senior Champion Commercial Doe: Chosen from all first place does in Classes 30-34. Reserve Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place does, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
35. Grand Champion Commercial Doe: Chosen from Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Commercial Doe shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood next to the Grand Champion in its individual age class.

## **SECTION 2A – PUREBRED BUCK CLASSES**

### **Junior Section**

1. Junior Buck Kid, up to 5 months as of show date.
2. Intermediate Buck Kid, 5-8 months as of show date.
3. Senior Buck Kid, 8 months but less than 12 as of show date.
4. Junior Champion Purebred Buck: Chosen from first place does in Classes 1 – 3. Reserve Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

### **Senior Section**

5. Yearling Buck, born 2016
6. Two Year old Buck born January 1 2015-December 31 2015
7. 3-4 Year Old Buck born January 1 2013- December 31-2014
8. 5 Year old and Up Buck born 2012 and older
9. Senior Champion Purebred Buck: Chosen from all first place does in Classes 5 – 8. Reserve Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place Bucks, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
10. Grand Champion Purebred Buck: Chosen from Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Buck shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood next to the Grand Champion in its individual age class.

## **SECTION 3A – REGISTERED GROUP CLASSES**

No entry fee, but entry must be made. Open to Purebred and Percentage animals.

The following classes are meant to give exhibitors a chance to learn more about their breeding program. The animals are judged by improvement in the next generation, consistency in quality of conformation, and type.

Points for Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder are not awarded. All animals must have already been shown in individual classes and those entered in a Special Class do not need to be owned by the same exhibitor.

1. Get-of-Sire: Two animals from the same buck
2. Produce-of-Dam: Two animals produced by the same dam.
3. Dam and Daughter: Dam and one daughter showing improvement in the next generation.
4. Sire and Son: Son showing improvement in the next generation.
5. Breeder's Herd: Four animals produced by the same herd.
6. Exhibitor's Herd: Four animals owned by the same herd, but not necessarily raised by the exhibitor.

## **SECTION 4A- MARKET KID CLASSES**

Market kids will be weighed prior to the show. Open to bucklings, wethers and doelings. Open to Youth Program animals. Individual animals cannot be shown in any other class (not applicable to Youth Program animals).

### **CLASSES**

1. Market Kid: under 50 lbs.
2. Market Kid: 50 – 70 lbs.
3. Market Kid: 71 – 90 lbs.
4. Market Kid: 91 lbs and over.
5. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Market Kid.
