GENERAL SHOW RULES 1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of SGBA Summer Extravaganza. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully. 2. This show is sanctioned by the Canadian Goat Society; therefore, CGS rules will govern. 3. Purebred and Recorded Grade entries must be registered with the CGS and CLRC. 4. CGS sanctions the following classes: Purebred Does, Recorded Does, Purebred Bucks. 5. All registered animals, regardless of age, must have original registration papers at the show. No papers, no show. 6. Commercial animals must have a recorded ear tag or tattoo. 7. Exhibitors are responsible for their own feed and bedding. Hay and Straw will be sold on site and able to order with entries. 8. Barns open for arrival of goats at 1 PM, Thursday July 27/2017, and all animals must be in the barns no later than 10:00PM Thursday July 27. Release begins at 8:00am. Sunday, July 30, and all exhibitors MUST be out by 8:00 PM on Sunday. Anyone needing to stay longer must be approved by the SGBA Summer Extravaganza. All exhibitors will receive one supper ticket, all exhibitors entering 3 or more animals will receive all seminars and speakers with entry package.

ENTRIES 1. Entry fee is \$25.00/entry. Entries close June 15/2017 at 8PM. 2. All animals entered/shown in Special Group Classes must be entered in the individual classes of their respected division. 3. Substitutions will be allowed until July 15 at 8PM. Only one substitution per exhibitor per class will be allowed. 4. Exhibitors wishing to substitute must email sgbasummerextravaganza@gmail.com with the information pertaining to substitution. 5. Late Entries will be allowed until June 30 at 8PM, late entries must be emailed to sgbasummerextravaganza@gmail.com and funds must be received no later then July , a late fee of 10\$ will apply to the entry fee for all late entries.

STALLING 1. **NO MORE THEN 3 MATURE ANIMALS PER STALL A OR 5 KIDS/JUNIORS/SMALL BREED GOATS.** 2. Stalling fee of \$51 per stall for the weekend will be charged. The stalling is based on Moose Exhibition grounds rules and pricing.

TATTOOS 1. Purebred and Recorded Grade animals must have legible tattoos. 2. Animals with unhealed tattoos may be disqualified and may not be allowed to show (show committee's discretion). 3. Illegible tattoos or tattoos not corresponding exactly to the information on the registration papers will result in disqualification and the animal will not be allowed to show.

HEALTH CHECK 1. All animals will be inspected by a veterinarian and/or committee of three CGS members in good standing for signs of parasites, disease, and infectious or contagious conditions. It is at the discretion of the committee to disqualify any animal with health faults. 2. Animals not passing inspection must, if deemed necessary by the veterinarian and/or committee, be removed from the premises. 3. Owners/exhibitors must be present during the vet check.

GRIEVANCE PROCESS 1. Any complaints must be made in writing and sent by 8:00 AM the day after the protest to the CGS, the SGBA, and the Show Committee. A copy with a \$100.00 deposit may be sent to SGBA Summer Extravaganza, where they will investigate. 2. Interrupting a show to complain is not acceptable. 3. Corrections can be made, if needed, after the show.

1. Junior Doe Kid, born June 1/2017 to show date
2. Intermediate Doe Kid, March 1-May 31/2017.
3. Senior Doe Kid, December 1/2016-February 28/2017.
4. Yearling Doe, dry (not having kidded), older then 12 months but less then 24.
5. Junior Champion Purebred Doe: Chosen from first place does in Classes 1 – 4. Reserve Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

Senior Section- ALL DOES MUST BE IN MILK

6. Yearling Doe, having kidded, born 2016
7. Two Year old Doe born January 1 2015-December 31 2015
8. 3-4 Year Old Doe born January 1 2013- December 31-2014
9. 5 Year old and Up Doe born 2012 and older
10. Senior Champion Purebred Doe: Chosen from all first place does in Classes 6 – 9. Reserve Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place does, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
11. Grand Champion Purebred Doe: Chosen from Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Doe shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood next to the Grand Champion in its individual age class.

Junior Section

12. Junior Doe Kid, born June 1/2017 to show date

13. Intermediate Doe Kid, March 1-May 31/2017.
14. Senior Doe Kid, December 1/2016-February 28/2017.
15. Yearling Doe, dry (not having kidded), older then 12 months but less then 24
16. Junior Champion Recorded Grade Doe: Chosen from first place does in Classes 12 – 15. Reserve Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

Senior Section- All DOES MUST BE IN MILK

17. Yearling Doe, having kidded, born 2016
18. Two Year old Doe born January 1 2015-December 31 2015
19. 3-4 Year Old Doe born January 1 2013- December 31-2014
20. 5 Year old and Up Doe born 2012 and older
21. Senior Champion Recorded Grade Doe: Chosen from all first place does in Classes 17 – 20. Reserve Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place does, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
22. Grand Champion Recorded Grade Doe: Chosen from Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Recorded Grade Doe shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood next to the Grand Champion in its individual age class.

SECTION 2A – PUREBRED BUCK CLASSES

Junior Section

1. Junior Doe Kid, born June 1/2017 to show date
2. Intermediate Doe Kid, March 1-May 31/2017.
3. Senior Doe Kid, December 1/2016-February 28/2017.
4. Yearling Doe, dry (not having kidded), older then 12 months but less then 24.
5. Junior Champion Purebred Doe: Chosen from first place does in Classes 1 – 4. Reserve Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

Senior Buck Section

6. Yearling Buck, born 2016
7. Two Year old Buck born January 1 2015-December 31 2015
8. 3-4 Year Old Buck born January 1 2013- December 31-2014
9. 5 Year old and Up Buck born 2012 and older
10. Senior Champion Purebred Buck: Chosen from all first place does in Classes 6 – 9. Reserve Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place does, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
11. Grand Champion Purebred Buck: Chosen from Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Buck shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood

next to the Grand Champion in its individual age class.

SECTION 3A – REGISTERED GROUP CLASSES

No entry fee, but entry must be made. Open to Purebred and Percentage animals.

The following classes are meant to give exhibitors a chance to learn more about their breeding program. The animals are judged by improvement in the next generation, consistency in quality of conformation, and type.

Points for Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder are not awarded. All animals must have already been shown in individual classes and those entered in a Special Class do not need to be owned by the same exhibitor.

1. Produce-of-Dam: Two animals produced by the same dam.
2. Dam and Daughter: Dam and one daughter showing improvement in the next generation.
3. Sire and Son: Son showing improvement in the next generation.
4. Get-of-Sire: Two animals from the same buck.
5. Breeder's Herd: Four animals produced by the same herd.
6. Exhibitor's Herd: Four animals owned by the same herd, but not necessarily raised by the exhibitor.
